Who's Eligible?

The mobile library offers a variety of French books, magazines, CD and DVDs to families currently enrolled in the EFGSeattle program.

Each family is granted a library membership valid until the last day of school in June. Membership is automatically renewed when the family re-enrolls the following year. Siblings not participating in the program are also eligible to borrow books.

Loan Privileges

Printed materials such as books, magazines or comic books, as well as CDs and DVDs may be borrowed **free** of charge. Any borrowed materials must be returned **on or before the 3rd Saturday of school following the loan.**

How to Find Us

The mobile library is available for book renewals or returns on school days beginning at 9:00 a.m. We will be located in the small common area near the school's front door. The library cart will be visiting each classroom to offer students an opportunity to borrow a book or games as a fun supplement to French class. Families are welcome to make new loans once the cart returns to the common area at around noon.

Loan Information

The mobile library of EFGSeattle is proud to offer its families a selection of French language printed materials, CDs and DVDs. Due to current low inventory, loans are limited to:

- 1 book or comic per child (same quota for siblings)
- AND**
- 1 magazine, CD or DVD per family

Games are currently reserved for classroom purposes.

Reservations/Holds

Currently, we are unable to offer reservation services for library materials.

Overdue Items

50 cents for each week past each item's due date. If your family will not attend school on the item's due date, you may return the item(s) the following school day without penalty.
